Rabbit food for small and medium-framed breeds

- deukanin standard is the inexpensive, all-purpose rabbit food.
- It ensures the basic supply of your rabbits - especially small and medium-framed breeds.

Ingredients

Crude protein	16,00 %
Crude fibre	17,00 %
Crude fat	2,60 %
Calcium	1,00 %
Phosphorus	0,60 %
Sodium	0,14 %

Lucerne meal, wheat semolina bran, oat hull bran, sunflower meal, ZR molasses, barley, calcium carbonate, sodium chloride

Feeding recommendation

Feed amounts in grams per kg body weight and day (as complete feed for small-framed breeds)*

Doe	<i>Breeding box</i>	30-40 g
	<i>low-bearing</i>	35-40 g
Male	<i>less active</i>	30-40 g
Young rabbits	<i>for breeding</i>	30-40 g
all rabbits	<i>in preparation for breeding shows</i>	35-40 g

*When used as supplementary feed to hay, grass, carrots or similar: reduce the indicated feed quantity up to 50 %.

The recommended feed quantities are for orientation and are to be adjusted according to condition and performance depending on the breed. For optimal ration design, regular weight control is important.

Note on breeds:

Small & dwarf breeds: Weight up to approx. 2 kg such as small rams, Leinchinchilla, small pinto etc.

Medium breeds: Weight approx. 3 - 4 kg such as Viennese, New Zealand, Rex, Angora rabbits etc.

Large breeds: Weight approx. 5 - 7 kg such as German Giants, German Rams, Helle Großsilber etc.
